Congenital Heart Disease of Great Complexity

These patients should be seen regularly at adult congenital heart disease centers.

- Conduits, valved or nonvalved
- Cyanotic congenital heart (all forms)
- Double-outlet ventricle
- Eisenmenger syndrome
- Fontan procedure
- Mitral Atresia
- Single ventricle (also called double inlet or outlet, common or primitive)
- Pulmonary atresia (all forms)
- Pulmonary vascular obstructive diseases
- Transposition of the great arteries
- Congenitally Corrected Transposition of the great arteries
- Tricuspid atresia
- Truncus arteriosus/hemitruncus
- Other abnormalities of atrioventricular or ventriculoarterial connection not included above (i.e., crisscross heart, isomerism, heterotaxy syndromes)
