The Department of Pediatrics at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, Division of Cardiology at Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital seeks a full-time Adult Congenital Heart Disease Cardiologist on the non-tenure-eligible Clinician-Educator track at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor. Proposed rank will be determined by qualifications.

This position focuses on program development as well as expansion of clinical outreach in ACHD throughout the greater-Chicago area and Midwest. Responsibilities will include outpatient ACHD care, ACHD inpatient service, and ACHD program development. Faculty will work at Lurie Children's Hospital and clinics as well as Northwestern Memorial Hospital, and outreach sites in the Greater-Chicago Area. Responsibilities will also include teaching fellows, residents, and medical students. Pursuit of individual scholarly interests is encouraged and supported. Mentorship is also available for faculty to aid with career development.

Qualified candidates will have an M.D. or D.O. and be eligible for an Illinois medical license. Qualifications include Board Certification/Board Eligibility in Cardiology. Applicants should have completed a categorical fellowship in Cardiology as well as advanced training in adult congenital heart disease and Board Certification/Board Eligibility in Adult Congenital Heart Disease. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The start date is negotiable, and the position will remain open until filled.

Cardiac intensive care services are provided in the state-of-the-art 44-bed Regenstein Cardiac Care Unit.
